TERMS & CONDITIONS

1 Eligibility

- Must be a financial Exhibitor at the current Show.
- Must be a Member of the Canterbury A&P Association.
- Members of Committee not eligible for nomination.
- Exhibitors in any Section of the Show able to be nominated.
- An Exhibitor may be nominated more than once but is ineligible for further nomination having won the Award.

2 Judging

- The Convenor of the Judging Panel must receive nomination forms with photos and bios from Section Chairmen by 5pm Friday 23 October 2009.
- Judges will take into account the following, in order of priority:
 - Continued loyalty to the A&P Movement.
 - Support shown to the Canterbury A&P Association.
 - Potential benefits to the Canterbury A&P Association should the nominee receive the Award.
 - Standard of the nominees current exhibit.

3 Judges

- The Panel of Judges shall consist of:
 - R R Anderson (Convenor) Past President of Canterbury A&P Association
 - Past President of Canterbury A&P Association
 - Senior Vice President of Canterbury A&P Association
 - Junior Vice President of Canterbury A&P Association
 - Representative of Award Sponsor

4 Nominations

- Nominations are to be made through Show Section Chairmen.
- More than one nomination per Section is encouraged and desirable.
- Nominations may be discussed with the Convenor prior to submission of a form.

5 Award Recipient

- To receive \$3000 to allow travel to an international A&P Show.
- To receive a Silver Salver for perpetual competition, to be held for one year.
- To attend and speak to a Committee Luncheon or AGM in March.
- To furnish a written report on Show visit highlighting areas of future benefit to the Canterbury A&P Association.
